

Regulations for the appointment of EECERA Officers and eligibility for the Electoral College:

President

The President is elected by secret ballot of the Board of Trustees for a period of three years.

Those seeking election require a Proposer and a Secunder.

The President must be a Trustee.

They may be re-elected.

The Vice President has a deciding vote in the event of a drawn ballot.

Vice President

The Vice President is elected by secret ballot of the Board of Trustees for a period of three years.

Those seeking election require a Proposer and a Secunder.

The Vice President must be a Trustee.

The Vice President is usually of a different gender to the President.

They may be re-elected.

The President has a deciding vote in the event of a drawn ballot.

Coordinating Editor

The Coordinating Editor is appointed by the Board of Trustees for a period of three years.

They may be re-elected.

The President has a deciding vote when necessary to reach a decision on the appointment.

Trustees

Trustees are elected to the Board for a period of three years by a secret ballot within the Electoral College.

The Executive Officers of the Association do not have to submit to the Electoral College for re-election as Trustees if still in office when their re-election would be due but must do so at the end of their period in office.

Any member of the Electoral College who has a Proposer and Secunder will be eligible to stand for election to the Board.

The Electoral College convenes at the EECERA Annual Conference whenever vacancies on the Board arise.

Electoral College

The Electoral College elects Trustees by ballot from its membership. Membership of the Electoral College is comprised of:

- the EECERA Board of Trustees and former Trustees;
- previous EECERA Conference Chairs;
- Chairs of Special Interest Groups of three years standing;
- Editors of EECERJ Special Issues;
- Members of the EECERJ Editorial Board;
- Current EECERA Members with 3 or more years of consecutive membership;
- Current country co-ordinators with 3 or more years of consecutive service.

Participation of the Electoral College is also dependent on current paid-up EECERA Membership.
